



## 2013 - Energy Project Award Application

### Requirements:

To qualify the project must be physically executed within New England

**(Note - Connecticut applications will be deferred to that Chapter)**

The Project must have been completed prior to December 31<sup>st</sup> 2013.

We are looking for **creative projects that push the envelope for creativity and / or comprehensiveness.**

**Page 1 - Complete a brief description of the project** to include all of the measures, including the benefits of the measures, and how energy is saved.

**Page 2 - Prepare a summary of the savings** for all energy and or water sources as well as any other savings.

**Page 3 - Prepare a summary of the costs,** incentives, tax credits, financing etc. Please include all typical ROI (Return on Investment) type information.

**Page 4 - Include a narrative by the customer** to explain their experience and results from the process.

**Page 5 - Include the key players** (Engineer, sales, project manager, utility staff (if any) and their roles involved including the customers key players (we recognize customer input.)

**Page 6 – Information on the companies involved** – The vendors, engineers, equipment suppliers as well as information about the customer and the customers business.

The application should be no more than 6 pages in length – If we have questions we will follow up for the details
