Requirements:

To qualify the project must be physically executed within New England

(Note - Connecticut applications will be deferred to that Chapter)

The Project must have been completed prior to December 31st 2013.

We are looking for creative projects that push the envelope for creativity and / or comprehensiveness.

- **Page 1 -** Complete a brief description of the project to include all of the measures, including the benefits of the measures, and how energy is saved.
- **Page 2 -** <u>Prepare a summary of the savings</u> for all energy and or water sources as well as any other savings.
- **Page 3 -** <u>Prepare a summary of the costs,</u> incentives, tax credits, financing etc. Please include all typical ROI (Return on Investment) type information.
- Page 4 <u>Include a narrative by the customer</u> to explain their experience and results from the process.
- **Page 5 -** <u>Include the key players</u> (Engineer, sales, project manager, utility staff (if any) and their roles involved including the customers key players (we recognize customer input.)
- **Page 6** <u>Information on the companies involved</u> The vendors, engineers, equipment suppliers as well as information about the customer and the customers business.

The application should be no more than 6 pages in length – If we have questions we will follow up for the details

The applicants will be notified of the awards by April 28th
